Policy Title: Health Requirements for International Applicants

Responsible Office: Office of International Education and Programs

Reason for Policy/Purpose:

This policy sets forth medical documentation required by international applicants.

Definition of Terms:

For purposes of this policy, applicants to the University of West Florida will be considered “International” students if they are not U.S. citizens and if they require a visa to remain in the United States. Applicants who are permanent residents of the United States are not considered international students.

Policy Statement:

Prior to enrollment in the University of West Florida or in its Intensive English Program, each accepted international student is required to provide a completed Mandatory Immunization Health History Form signed by the student and the student’s physician (additional information is available at the UWF Student Health Services’ website at www.uwf.edu/healthcenter).

Change Justification: This policy is being amended to reflect current practice and to reflect current regulatory requirements.
