University of West Florida - Division of Academic Affairs Collection and Use of Social Security Numbers

In accordance with Florida Statute 119.071(5), students should be aware the University of West Florida Division of Academic Affairs collects and uses social security numbers for the purpose of performing certain university duties and responsibilities as follows:

- Identification and verification of student records, including admission, registration, academic records, financial records as well as verification of identity in connection with the provision of the University's services;
- State and federal reporting of student data as required by law. UWF does not use social security
 numbers for student identification; instead the University assigns each student a UWF student
 identification number (UWF ID). Florida Statute 1008.386 requires school districts to request the Social
 Security numbers of enrolling students for recordkeeping purposes, and FS 119.071 governs the use of
 those numbers. You are not, however, required to provide your child's Social Security number as a
 condition of enrollment.
